



Learn about Hunger

No one deserves to be hungry.

This basic principle guides much of the work we do at Hoosier Hills Food Bank. It's important to learn about the people we serve and how hunger affects their lives.

The Hoosier Hills Food Bank:

- Distributes food products in a six-county service area in South Central Indiana. **41,740 people, or 16.5%** of the total population, in the HHFB service area are food insecure. (Feeding America Map the Meal Gap Study)
- Provides food to approximately **26,000 individuals each month** in our service area
- Rescued, on average, over 308,300 pounds of food each month in 2013

Hunger is an income issue, an indicator of the growing disparity between income and expenses.
